Festival Hours: 10:00 AM. - 4:00 PM. **DISPLAY BOOTHS:** Booths are 15' wide by 15' deep. Spaces are assigned with no guarantee to get the same spot as in a previous year. Tents must be supported or anchored by appropriate weights. Electricity is not available and generators are prohibited. A limited number of booths with expanded space are available for an additional \$25.

SALES: Artists transact all sales and receive all proceeds. Artists are responsible for complying with State of Michigan tax rules.

LIABILITY: The William Bonifas Fine Arts Center assumes no responsibility for loss of or damage to any work, display or personal property.

REFUNDS: Cancellations received before June1st will be granted a full refund. Cancellations received before June 22nd (45 days) will be granted half the refund. Cancellations received on or after June -22nd-will-not-be-granted a-refund.

WATERFRONT ART RAFFLE: Artists are asked to donate a piece of their artwork for the annual Waterfront Raffle. The Bonifas Arts Center uses all proceeds to promote art and cultural activities in the Central Upper Peninsula.

SHOW AWARDS: Identify the medium in which your work should be evaluated on the application.

Best of Show: Winner receives a monetary award and a ribbon. All artists are invited to enter one piece in this competition, challenging themselves to achieve new heights in design, technique, originality and individual creativity. Artists will receive a sign to be displayed with the piece to be judged.

Best of Category Award: The Bonifas Arts Center will present a monetary award and a ribbon for Best of Category in each of the following medium categories — Pottery, Photography, Jewelry, Fibers, Painting, Prints/Drawing, Mixed Media and 3D (including sculpture, glass and metal work).

APPLICATION: APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JULY 21, 2018

Each participating artist must submit:

- 1. A completed application form (see reverse). Include your email address for confirmation purposes.
- Jury Process—submit digital image files via email or a CD for the jurying process. This is NOT a requirement if you were participated in the Waterfront in 2016 or 2017.

ELIGIBILITY: All work must be the artist's own design/concept/execution. Only original works or signed/numbered prints may be exhibited, with no more than half of the work displayed being reproductions. Reproductions must be labeled as such. Examples of unacceptable work: commercially-made products, kits or settings of jewelry or lapidary work, items from commercial fabric forms.

JURY PROCESS

In order to accelerate the process and help artists schedule their show season, we have moved to a rolling application process. All applications received by the 1st of each month will be reviewed and artists notified within 14 days if they are accepted into the show.

Acceptability will be based on originality, technique, design and variety within mediums. Note: If you participated in the 2016 or 2017 Waterfront Art Festival you do not need to be juried in. Simply complete steps 1 & 3 of the Application Process (at left).
